Thirty years ago, I launched this Speak Mandarin Campaign Chinese students learn Mandarin in school Unfortunately, they used to speak dialects among themselves and at home When I watched interviews on our Chinese TV channel in the 1960s and „70s, I found students and workers speak Mandarin haltingly They have not used Mandarin often
